



Work regulations at Local Kid NGO

- 1. Respect each other and be friendly to each other. We are one Team and we are dependent on each other.
- 2. Respect your role at Local KID
- 3. No one works alone.
- 4. Talk in the team and with the Directors about new Ideas and changes, before doing it.
- 5. Don't steal
- 6. Don't beat and abuse children, students or other people.
- 7. Respect the children/ Students and take care of them the way you take care of yourself..
- 8. Treat the children/ students the way you want to be treated as well.
- 9. Respect the Community and people we work with.
- 10. Attend Meetings, Internships and Workshops
- 11. Sign in and out before and after work.
- 12. All materials which belong to Local KID have to be returned after using them
- 13. Respect the work hours and workplan
- 14. Don't be late to work
- 15. Communicate to the team if you are sick or not coming
- 16. Communicate to Chiara Katende if you want holidays or days off.
- 17. After 7pm in the evening no child enters or leaves the home. Doors remain closed.
- 18. Duty of Care: Take care of the nonprofit by ensuring prudent use of all assets, including facility, people, and good will;
- 19. Duty of Loyalty: Ensure that the nonprofit's activities and transactions are, first and foremost, advancing its mission; Recognize and disclose conflicts of interest; Make decisions that are in the best interest of the nonprofit corporation; not in the best interest of the individual board member (or any other individual or for-profit entity).
- 20. Duty of Obedience: Ensure that the nonprofit obeys applicable laws and regulations; follows its own bylaws; and that the nonprofit adheres to its stated corporate purposes/mission.
